Video formats

- **.AVI** is a Microsoft standard that is playable on Windows and Macintosh machines.
- **.FLV** files are flash and they don't play on Windows Media player.
- **.MPEG** is playable on Unix and Windows machines. Macintoshes can play MPEG, but may have trouble with the audio track.
- **.WMV** format used in Microsoft MovieMaker.

IDEAS FOR STUDENTS 'OWN VIDEOS

- Students collect pictures of themselves growing up over several years. Students write a script including a short statement about each of the pictures. Each picture is then video recorded using Windows movie Maker. Students then narrate their script with music playing about each of the pictures.
- Each classroom creates a presentation about their group and the individuals in it. Presentations
- About what sports they practice , where they live , families etc.
- Students write their own recipes. They cook and record them preparing a presentation.
- Students play the roles of TV presenters for documentaries or News.
